Grade 9 Application Deadline: All application materials must be received by March 1st for Grade 9 applicants, to be entered into the Admission Lottery. Students who submit late applications will be drawn from a subsequent lottery only if additional seats become available, in accordance with the school's published admission, recruitment and retention policy.

Grade 10 Application Deadline: All application materials must be received by June 15th for Grade 10 applicants. An Admission Lottery for upperclassmen will not occur until after our summer school ends in mid-August, and only if there are more applicants than there are available seats.

In order to be eligible to apply and be accepted to Montachusett Regional Vocational Technical School, incoming students must reside in one of the above named communities. A family must establish residency by ensuring that the student applicant sleeps at the address provided on the application during the majority of each week. Therefore, residency is not established simply by renting or owning a property in the town. Once accepted, freshmen must maintain residency throughout their freshmen year in one of the above communities. If residency is in question during the application process, additional proof of residency may be requested.
