Participants must:

- Be between 18-35 years of age;
- Be currently unemployed, but interested in gaining skills necessary to succeed in a forward-facing, mainstream working environment;
- Have a diagnosed disability, and
- Have the ability to develop technical and "soft" skills that include: communication skills, listening skills, time management, and problemsolving skills.

What is Monty Tech STEP?

- 9 weeks of hands-on training, delivered by highly qualified vocational educators, supported by para-educators from CAPS Collaborative, in your choice of 7 different programs:
 - Culinary
 - Baking
 - Restaurant Operations
 - Pet Care

- Basic Carpentry/Assembly
- Facilities Maintenance
- o Office & Retail Assistant
- 1 week of work readiness and professional skills training, delivered by our Professional Skills Instructor
- 2 weeks of paid internship experience with employer partners in our area

Participants will receive:

- A Training Attendance/Completion Stipend of \$500
- An Internship Completion Stipend of \$120
- Uniforms and tools needed to succeed in their chosen program
