- Three students, accompanied by Monty Tech staff, participated at the 2022 SkillsUSA National Leadership & Skills Conference, held in Atlanta, Georgia.
- The school has begun the transition to a new Student Information System, PowerSchool.
- On Thursday, July 28th, Superintendent Browne and Principal Carlson were invited to a meeting at Fitchburg State University by President Richard Lapidus to discuss potential partnerships.
- Monty Tech has been awarded \$109,988 from the Massachusetts Life Sciences Center.
- Friday, July 22, Monty Tech was invited to Minuteman Regional Vocational Technical School, where Governor Baker, Lt. Governor Polito, and members of the Workforce Skills Cabinet awarded Monty Tech the Skills Capital Grant of \$399,546 for HVAC & Prop. Maintenance.
