Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to share information with you about the spring 2021 **MCAS testing schedule for grades 9 and 10 students.** As you may know, the state Board of Elementary and Secondary Education has determined that MCAS is still a state graduation requirement for current students in grade 9 and 10, so these students are still required to pass the MCAS in order to earn their Competency Determination (CD).

Students in the class of 2023 (current 10<sup>th</sup> graders) must take and pass the MCAS in English Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics to earn a high school diploma, in addition to meeting local requirements. Students in the class of 2024 (current 9<sup>th</sup> graders) are required to take and pass the Biology MCAS this year. Next year, these students will also be required to take and pass the MCAS ELA and mathematics exams. All students will have an opportunity to participate in future retest exams if they do not pass.

The high school MCAS also provides the following opportunity for students to qualify for several state awards and/or scholarships. More information is available on how to qualify for the John and Abigail Adams Scholarship and the Stanley Z. Koplik Certificate of Mastery Award in the links below.

Unlike elementary and middle school exams, the option of taking the high school MCAS exam is not available remotely, so all participating freshmen and sophomores will be required to come to school and sit for the exam. However, for those students who remain in our Remote Learning Only program, a separate testing location will be provided. In addition, these remote students will be able to return home after testing is completed.
